Official language of the Meeting: English. *Criteria for the evaluation of papers have been:* a) Originality on a new subject-basis: 40%, or on an existing concept: 30%, b) Social impact: 25%, c) Statistical support or sufficient proof of results: 25%, d) Typical and simple presentation, easy to qualify: 10%. Total: 90%-100%.

Three high prizes will be awarded to the three best papers among all. The 3 high prizes will be accompanied by a monetary award of 500€, 400€ and 300€ respectively which may be increased. One to three prizes will be awarded to papers from every specialty. The nuclear medicine prize will be accompanied by a monetary amount of 300€.

Authors may publish their papers under their own care to the Journals they wish after 5-10-2015. In the final programme: the abstract and the title of the accepted papers, the Authors' names and degrees and their Institute-Clinic or Laboratory will be published, as submitted by the Authors.

There will be only one welcome lecture at the Welcome ceremony. The Chairpersons of every session will have a few minutes to introduce the speakers. For every paper to be presented, at least *one author should be registered. The time allowed for every paper to be orally presented will be 15min and for discussion, 5min. Authors are kindly requested to comply with this timetable. For more information please contact us at the e-mail address of the Association.*

All participants to the Olympiad and their accompanying members are invited to participate to the Sunday 4-10-2015 excursion in magnificent places and a small restaurant at 1200 meters, in Mount Olympus, escorted by an experienced tourist guide.
